COVID Protocol:

- If you have COVID-19 symptoms (e.g., cough, sore throat, fever, headache) on Test Day, stay home.
- Masks are welcome for all students, faculty, staff, and visitors.
- The Host Institution may deny your participation if you show COVID-19 symptoms. In such cases, test fees will not be refunded.

Reporting Time and Test Schedule:

- Arrive during your scheduled reporting time and go directly to your assigned classroom. Bring your **admission voucher** (printed is fine) and **valid photo ID** for check-in.
- If you arrive early, wait outside the building. Entry begins at **11:30 AM**. Do not enter before then. The info desk is only for questions or directions. Special Accommodation test takers can enter 30 minutes before their reporting time.
- Allow extra travel time in case of delays. If flying after the test, book a later flight to ensure you have enough time to reach the airport.

What to Bring to the Test Site:

You **MUST** bring the following:

- **Admission voucher** (printed copy).
- **Valid photo ID** (no copies).
 - Acceptable: driver's license, passport, or student ID.
 - Not accepted: social security cards, credit/debit cards.
 - The name on your ID **must match** your voucher.
 - Expired or missing ID = no entry and you will be marked absent.
- **Several sharpened No. 2 or HB pencils** and an **eraser**.
 - Pens are not allowed.
 - Pencils/erasers are not provided.
 - Mechanical pencils are allowed but not recommended as they may hinder machine-grading.

Cell Phones and Electronic Devices

- Avoid bringing cell phones or electronic devices with camera, memory, or wireless functions.
- If you must bring a phone, it must be **turned off** and **stored in the provided bag** for the entire test, including breaks.
- If your phone makes **any noise**, even on vibrate or by accident, your test will be **voided**, and

you will **not receive a score for the test.**

- Use of **any phone**, even one that isn't yours, will also invalidate your test.
- **Smartwatches, smart glasses, laptops, tablets**, and similar devices are also **prohibited** and will be treated the same way. We strongly recommend you **do not bring any of these items.**

Prohibited Materials – Do Not Bring:

1. Electronic devices (e.g., PDAs, pagers, computers, recording devices).
2. A watch that beeps or has an alarm.
3. Handwritten or printed materials, such as cheat sheets on paper, Japanese characters on clothing or personal items are not permitted. Please cover any tattoos with Japanese characters.
4. Food or drinks (except **water** in a **clear, label-free bottle** with a **secure lid**).
 - Water must be stored in your bag under your seat, not on your desk.
 - Only vending machines are available near the test site. Campus dining facilities will be closed so eat before arriving.
5. If you are traveling with prohibited items or luggage, you must leave them with a proctor in your assigned classroom.
 - Personal bags must be kept **under your seat** and **must not block walkways.**

General Testing Guidelines:

- Dress in layers to stay comfortable in any room temperature (Fourth floor get warm for N1).
- Guests are not allowed in the classrooms but may wait in the designated area.
- Do not leave the test room until dismissed by a proctor. If you feel sick and need to leave, inform a proctor so they can escort you out.

Directions:

- **Public Transportation:**

California State LA is one stop east of Union Station on Metrolink's **San Bernardino Line**. Use the Sunday schedule.

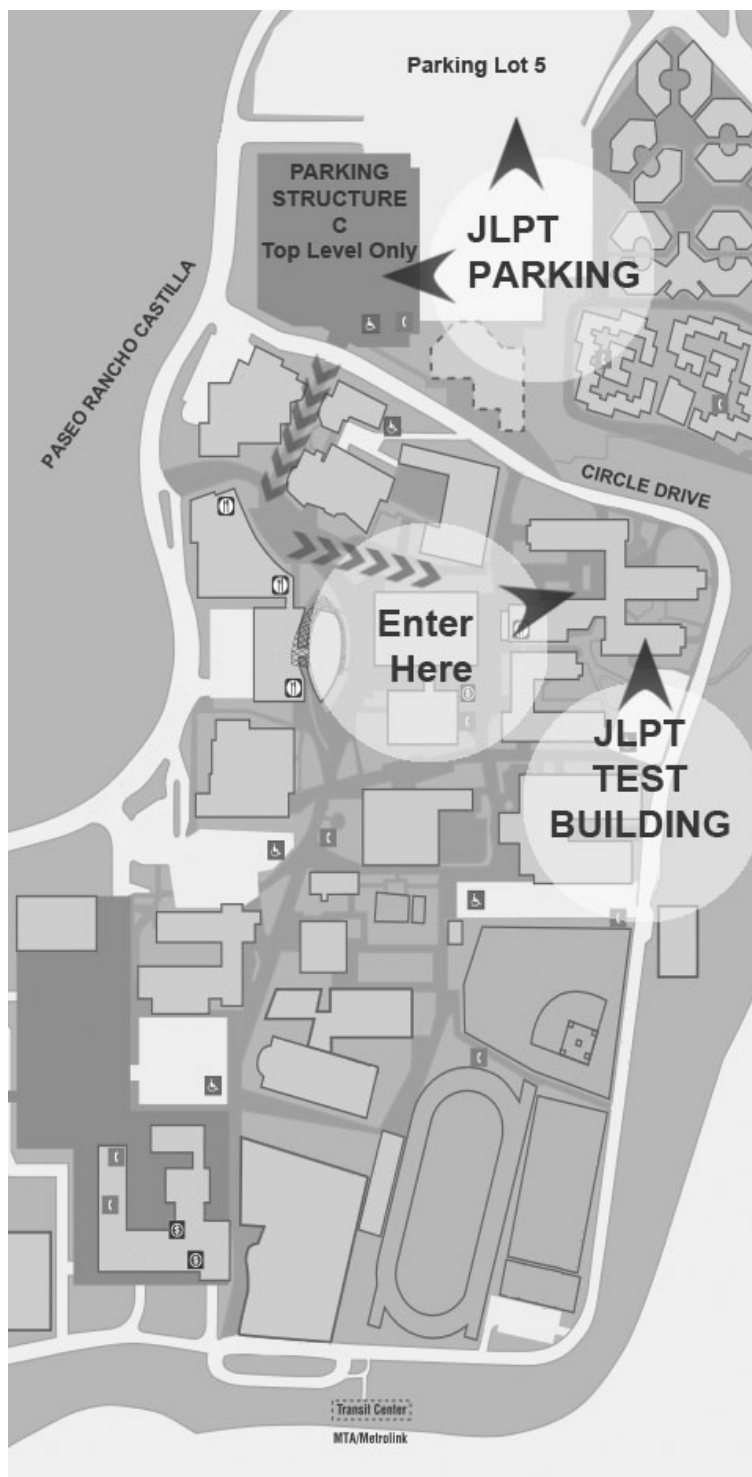
